SUCCESSFUL RESULTS FOR CACLP 2022 AND CONCURRENT ACTIVITIES



The 19th edition of China Association of Clinical Laboratory Practice Expo (CACLP) and the 2nd China IVD Supply Chain Expo (CISCE) – the world leading exhibition for in vitro diagnostics – was successfully held from 25 to 28 October in Nanchang, China.
